- Neighbor named that repeated calls to 911 before a timely response from patrol is a problem and unacceptable
- 4) Neighbor shared that a neighbor's home (a police officer's home) was tagged with graffiti
- 5) Neighbor shared concerns about motorccyles coming off of Harrison exit
- 6) Neighbor shared concerns about excessive loitering occurring at Lotus and Madison and Lockwood and Madison, likely more than selling loose cigarettes because has witnessed bikes biking back and forth between the two intersections. Also concerned that there are no loitering laws in Chicago
