The district strategic plan - Robbery. Harden their vehicles, homes. Anti-Theft literature. CHA buildings - racist efforts and it flies under the radar on the frontline public safety workers. Processing of the officer-involved shootings at Swedish two weeks ago

We know more now, but there are still many things we don't know about what happened.

We DO know what CPD policies and procedures are in place that are relevant to this situation, and we can review those today. From 2017, 2012, and 2023 - are there updates we should be advocating for for these related policies?

BIA is investigating the situation - the officers who arrested him are different from the officers who transported him/were with him in the hospital. What happened? What kind of review does BIA do, and will it unearth any systems failures/procedures failures, as opposed to individual failures? Incident review.

Conducting Strip Searches (2017) - General Order - Must report and use strip search form if a strip search is conducted; there are situations in which a strip search CANNOT be used; people CAN be strip searched in cases involving weapons; must get written permission (search warrant) from CPD leadership to do so

Why was he arrested by a group of officers, handed off to another group of officers, and was able to maintain his weapon in that transport AND into a hospital? What are the CPD transport policies AND what are the hospital intake policies? Why did they not make sure there was no weapon, via a pat-down or a wand (even if not a strip search)?

How can we approach this from not assigning individual blame, and instead looking at the policies and systems in place (policies that need to be updated? procedures that need to systematically reviewed by district? retraining that needs to happen for officers?)

Chicago Police need to be trained better - there should be a higher level of professionalism in the department overall. Is there adequate training happening for responding to an incident of this magnitude? What trauma informed care are they trained on as officers (like CP4P)?

Emergency updates to the community leave a lot to be desired ACROSS Chicago (OEMC alerts are not sufficient or timely). An armed man at large in the community should trigger a lockdown response in the area. People should not be running outside to see what's going on, and buildings should not be being evacuated - they should be locked down.

We don't want to call into question the importance of pre-trial release. It is important that the SAFE-T Act is implemented AND it needs to be done well.

We don't want to militarize our healthcare system in the aftermath of incidents like this. AND we want to ensure there isn't retaliation in the community from police to the community, given an officer was killed.

Angelique Guzman is here tonight and will soon be on the Commission! The Commission can take up investigating Tact Teams and their operating policies and procedures.
