 - **Little Village (Year-to-Date):** 2 homicides, 3 shooting incidents, 3 shooting victimizations, 0 vehicle hijackings.
 - Updates on benefits changes:
 - Mandatory 80 hours/month of volunteer or work hours for benefits (effective Feb 1).
 - St. Anthony and MLK building accepting walk-ins for assistance.
 - Community programs and events:
 - Firehouse Community Center dance program (Feb 23–May 9).
 - Chicago Food Depository partnership for volunteer hour sign-offs.
 - Party for Socialism and Liberation event on Feb 20 at 2712 W. Surman (film screening, free pizza, childcare).

 - Complaints filed with OIG regarding:
 - Unaddressed 311 complaints and missed inspections by Department of Buildings.
 - Aggressive traffic stops in the 10th District (e.g., 12 police cars for one stop).
